

Port Chester High School Band Association Scholarship Guidelines

Guideline Purposes

Guidelines were created to standardize the process necessary for use by the yearly-appointed Scholarship Committee in selection of awards to graduating seniors who are band members either as a musician or in the auxiliary.

A basic criterion to be used for selection was narrowed to five (5) major categories. Points were assigned as necessary to distinguish its relative importance in determining award recipients. Where necessary, sub classifications were established and assigned points. When completed, eligible applicants will be awarded scholarship amounts based on total points received.

CATEGORIES & SUBCLASSIFICATIONS

- I. CONTRIBUTION TO BAND – (to be determined by Band Director) - 25 POINTS**
Band Director has assigned point values as follows:
 - A. Dedication – 10 points
 - B. Leadership – 5 points
 - C. Attendance – 5 points
 - D. Conduct – 5 points

- II. FUNDRAISING**
 - A. The applicant must have fundraised 100% for all years he/she was a member of the Band.
 - B. Fundraising is defined as:
 1. 100% of quota through fundraising
 2. Payment of 100% of profit for quota
 3. Payment to meet 100% of quota when fundraising is insufficient.

- III. DUES-PAYING MEMBER**
 - A. The applicant's family must have been a dues-paying member for all years he/she was a member of the Band.

- IV. PROOF OF ACCEPTANCE TO A POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTION**
 - A. The applicant must submit proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution.

- V. ESSAY**
 - A. The applicant must submit an essay for informational purposes only.
